## IV. Open Forum:

- Reza Peigahi informed the Committee that minutes for this meeting will need to be approved electronically.
- Sue Holl discussed Joe Palermo's Sac Bee editorial (5/3/15) concerning the recent decision to by CSUS to allow an Anthropology course to satisfy the AI graduation requirement. Reza pointed out that it is important to recognize that the approval of the course took place after following the standard review process Kivel circulated a response she has prepared to send to the *Bee*; the Committee complemented her on it.

# V. GE Reform: long-term plan

- Chair Kivel pointed out the need to develop a long-term plan for GE Reform, particularly the need align them with Baccalaureate Learning Outcomes.
- Andrew Hertzoff suggested we begin with American Institution in Fall'15; Foreign language graduation requirement, Spring '16, Sheree Meyer suggested the Writing Intensive requirement take place in Spring S16, English 20 in Fal'16, and Race & Ethnicity in Fall'16.
- Sheree Meyer emphasized that there needs to be a sense of shared ownership in the process.
