

Getting Started with My Mediasite

Accessing My Mediasite


You have two options for accessing My Mediasite:

- Within SacCT, click the My Mediasite tab at the top of the screen or the My Mediasite link under Course Tools on the navigation menu.
- Log in to MyMediasite directly with your Sac State account at www.csus.edu/mymediasite.

My Mediasite Features

My Mediasite is your video library. You can upload, record, store, and distribute video all in one place. After logging in to My Mediasite, you will see:

- A “Create Presentation” button which allows you to upload existing video or launch the Desktop Recorder tool and record new video.
- A default folder structure to store and organize your videos (Everything, Private, Drafts, etc.)
- A “My Channels” area where you can create your own folders/channels to store and distribute video (e.g., create a folder to store and share videos for a particular class).
- A “Download the Desktop Recorder” button which allows you to install mediasite’s Desktop Recorder tool on your computer. This tool allows you to record your screen, record from a webcam, and/or record from a microphone to create video.
