- DEPENDABLE, CONSTRUCTIVE RELATIONSHIP
- MEET CLIENT WHERE CLIENT NEEDS TO BE MET
- ▶ SENSITIVE, COMPETENT

INITIAL SKILLS

- ASSESS SITUATION AND CIRCUMSTANCES IF POSSIBLE
- PARAPHRASE
- REFLECTION OF FEELING
- ▶ SUMMARIZE
- DIRECT CLIENT TOWARD CHANGES IN PERSPECTIVE
- DIRECTIVES
 - STATEMENTS OF CURIOSITY
- INTERNAL WORK
- OPEN ENDED QUESTION IF MUST
- SUPPORT COPING
- ASSESS FUNCTIONAL STATE AS NECESSARY

ASSESSMENT
SUICIDALITY AND MENTAL STATUS

RISK FACTORS: HIGHEST

- PREVIOUS ATTEMPTS
 SUICIDAL IDEATIONS
 SEEKING LETHAL MEANS TO KILL ONESELF
- LACK OF MEANING IN LIFE
 ANXIETY
- SLEEPLESSNESS
- SUBSTANCE ABUSE
- HOPELESSNESS
- SOCIAL WITHDRAWAL
- PATTERNS OF ANGER
- VICTIM OF SPOUSAL ABUSE OR CHILD ABUSE
- RECKLESSNESS
- MOOD CHANGES

Other factors

- OVER 45 YEARS OLD
- GENDER ISSUES: MEN TRY MORE LETHAL MEANS, WOMEN MORE OFTEN
- DIVORCED, WIDOWED, RECENTLY SEPARATED
 LOWEST RISK, NEVER MARRIED
- RECENT JOB LOSS

- IDENTITY CONFLICTED YOUTH
 CHRONIC ILLNESS
 RECENT LOSS OF LOVED AND ANNIVERSARY OF LOSS
- HISTORY OF SUICIDE IN THEIR FAMILY
- HISTORY OF IMPULSIVE OR RECKLESS BEHAVIOR
- RECENT HUMILIATION OR SHAME

Suicide Risk Assessment

- HIGH RISK
 - HISTORY OF LETHAL SUICIDE ATTEMPT(S)
 - PERSISTENT SUICIDE IDEATION OR INTERMITTENT IDEATION WITH INTENT
 - PSÝCHOSIS, HALLUCINATIONS ORDERING SELF-HARM
 - RECENT ONSET OF DEPRESSION OR OTHER PSYCHIATRIC DISORDERS
 - ESPECIALLY YOUTH WITH NEW ANTIDEPRESSANT PRESCRIPTION
 - RECENT TREATMENT FOR PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
 - HISTORY OF IMPULSIVE OR AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIORS

- MODERATE RISK
- SUICIDE IDEATION WITH SOME LEVEL OF SUICIDE INTENT, BUT WHO HAVE TAKEN NO ACTION ON THE PLAN
- CURRENTLY ATTENDING COUNSELLING OR PSYCHOTHERAPY
- LOW RISK
- SOME MILD OR PASSIVE SUICIDE IDEATION, WITH NO INTENT OR PLAN
- NO HISTORY OF SUICIDE ATTEMPT
- AVAILABLE SOCIAL SUPPORT
- HISTORY OF BORDERLINE PERSONALITY DIAGNOSIS

Underactivating responses

- LITTLE OR NO EMOTIONAL REACTION OBSERVED
- ▶ POSSIBLE STATES
 - NUMBING (SHOCK)
 - · DISSOCIATION
 - THOUGHT SUPPRESSION (INTERNALIZATION)
- DENIAL
- $^{\circ}$ MEDICATIONS BEFORE THE FACT

 - WHAT IS THIS USED FOR?
- > SHOW CLIENT A WATCH
 - WHAT IS THIS USED FOR?
- REPEAT AFTER ME, "NO IFS, ANDS, OR BUTS"
- TAKE THIS PIECE OF PAPER, FOLD IT IN HALF AND PUT IN ON THE FLOOR
- WHAT WOULD YOU DO IF YOU SAW A LOT OF SMOKE COMING FROM YOUR NEIGHBOR'S HOUSE?

Activation Skills

- EXPOSURE
 - DIRECTIVE
- DRAW ATTENTION TO CRITICAL NATURE OF EVENT
- REFLECT FEELINGS
- INTERNAL WORK
- FOCUS ON PERCEPTIONS
 - DIRECTIVES
 - STATEMENTS OF CURIOSITY
- DISPUTATIONS

If client becomes overactivated

- DON'T REINFORCE OVEREMOTIONALIZATION
- REFOCUS ON PERCEPTION, INTERNAL DIALOGUES, AUTOMATIC THOUGHTS, SELF STATEMENTS
- ▶ COUNTERCONDITIONING
 - REACT OPPOSITE OF EXPECTATIONS
 - RELAXATION
 - STATEMENTS OF AFFIRMATION OF DEFENSE MECHANISMS

Overactivation reactions

- PROCESS RESPONSE IS EMERGENCE OF POSTTRAUMATIC EMOTIONS, MEMORIES, COGNITIONS, ANTICIPATIONS
 - EMOTIONAL DYSREGULATION
 - ANXIETY, PANIC REACTIONS
 - · GUILT, SHAME
 - · SUICIDALITY
 - ACUTE PSYCHOTIC RESPONSE

Grounding skills

- FOCUS ATTENTION OF CLIENT ONTO COUNSELLOR
 - MOVE INTO RANGE OF SIGHT
- · CHANGE PITCH, VOLUME AND TENOR OF VOICE TO CALM
- ► CHANGE FOCUS INTERVENTION PROCESS
- DIRECT CLIENT TOWARD SENSORIUM
- ▶ REORIENT TO IMMEDIATE ENVIRONMENT
- DEEP BREATHING
- RELAXATION

AVOIDANT RESPONSES

- INTERNALIZATION (DANGER IS PTSD)
- SUBSTANCE USE OR ABUSE
- PSYCHOSOMATIC RESPONSE

AVOIDANCE SKILLS

- ▶ EMPATHIZE
 - PARAPHRASE
 - REFLECT FEELINGS
- DEVELOP DISCREPANCY
- ▶ AVOID ARGUMENT
- ROLL WITH RESISTANCE
