Justification for this deactivation request

ANTH 164 is being deactivated as it is a course that has not been offered for instruction for many years, and is now considered considerably out of date by our faculty. It was originally designed and taught during a disciplinary period in which historical and cultural transformations were often treated in isolation as phenomena to be studied independently of 'more static' aspects of culture. Current faculty have no interest in teaching the course. ANTH 164 has not been included within the existing major or in the revised concentrations (see Form B), and if deactivated, will have no impact on the anthropology major going forward.
