Overview

The Placer Campus is a 301-acre property in Placer County that will expand Sacramento State's regional, statewide, and inter/national impact for generations to come. Our goal is to advance a new model of higher education that focuses on 3 key areas:

- **All-in-One Communiversality:** Build a seamless concurrent enrollment system that allows students to take courses at a community college and CSU simultaneously. Develop academic pathways that support students from community college to doctoral degrees. The Communiversality framework was created and launched by Dr. Vajra Watson in 2023; it blends "community" and "university" to describe a dynamic partnership between educational institutions and local communities, fostering mutual impact and innovation.
- **Develop Interdisciplinary Degree Programs:** Work with faculty to design the future of our fields, giving particular

attention to paid academic internships and innovative industry partnerships.

- **Centralize Wellness:** A health and healing framework allows us to advance equity, access and belonging as our foundation and destination. This connects to our relationship with the land, Indigenous communities, and our sacred legacy as leaders for justice.

Partnership Opportunities:

- Capital support and naming opportunities for Phase I buildings, including the first instructional building and library.
- Naming opportunities for staff, including a crime lab director and endowed professors.
- Funding for educational programs and equipment.

We invite you to partner with us as we make this new higher education model a reality.
