**E-Learning Policy:** The policy will be returned to CPC to consider addressing several items: 1) The term “hybrid course” is used several times but the term is never defined. CPC should consider defining this term or removing references to it. 2) Neither the Credit Hour Policy nor the E-Learning Policy define a credit hour for an online course. CPC should determine if the definition of an online credit hour should be added to the E-Learning Policy. 3) Academic units report course modalities, which are then reported to the Chancellor’s Office. There are four categories of course modalities used by the Chancellor’s Office. Consider consulting with Academic Affairs about adding language to list these four categories.
