 Philosophy Department Statement Responding to the Intersegmental Committee of Academic Senates (ICAS) Proposal on AB 928.
Shared per the request of the Philosophy faculty.

The body discussed the merits of and disadvantages of the various alternative options to the ICAS recommendation. Some senators reported the feedback from their respective units. The Chair shared that some of the restrictions laid out in some of the alternative options (e.g., not double-counting Area D and American Inst.) should not be part of any CSU recommendation to the ASCSU since the restrictions involve requirements specific to the Sac State Campus. He also shared that the GE/GR Policies Committee will not be putting forward a recommendation but are instead drafting a resolution in dissent of legislative intrusions into CSU curricular matters as well as calls for action at the system level to address GE concerns arising from whatever recommendation is implemented.

After the Committee of the Whole discussion concluded, senators discussed several paths the Senate could take on how to proceed. The Chair stated that he would consult with Senator Lascher, who has some expertise in matters of voting, and the Executive Committee to arrive at a strategy for deciding the campus feedback at the October 20 Senate meeting.
