All University Expenses

Budget that is allocated to a division to cover expenditures that are restricted to a specific type of expense and cannot be used for any other purpose.

- Costs are ongoing in nature and have university wide implications that are beyond the normal scope of operations for any one division, program center, or department.
- Due to the nature of the expense, the division may have little control over the expenditures (e.g. utility or insurance premium costs).



All University Expenses (AUEs)

2024-25 Allocation

AUE Definition: Budget that is allocated to a division to cover expenditures that are restricted to a specific type of expense and cannot be used for any other purpose. Costs are ongoing in nature and have university wide implications that are beyond the normal scope of operations for any one division, program center, or department. Due to the nature of the expense, the division may have little control over the expenditures (e.g. utility or insurance premium costs). Permanent salaried positions should not be included in this category because these costs are controllable by the division. AUEs are managed by the central Budget Office.

Criteria for Short Term Space Rentals

- Serves a population of the University (students, staff, faculty)
- Historically has been granted the authority to utilize the AUE through a pre-approved allocation (e.g., fall and spring addresses).
- Benefits the University through utilizing the space to enhance the imperatives, anchor work, or educational mission.
- Event shall be non-profit, educational, non-commercial, characterbuilding or charitable.
- Voluntary sponsorships, events where the department hosting is the primary benefactor, and events that primarily serve a population outside of the University are excluded from utilizing this portion of the AUE.
 - Cancellation fees are also excluded from utilizing this AUE.



Criteria for Parking

- Visitor(s) must attend or participate in a University-sponsored program/event that
 - Occurs during the academic year;
 - Is sponsored by a College or academic department;
 - Is funded by the General Operating Fund; and
 - Does not charge a fee or charge for admission (ticketed event)
- Visitor(s) participation in University-sponsored program must enhance the students' educational experience at Sac State.
- Visitor(s) are not receiving any compensation, stipend, honorarium, course credit, or any other form of remuneration from Sac State for their participation.
- AUE funds may only be used to cover vehicle parking costs for visitors who meet the criteria above; it will not be used for additional parking-related costs such as paid visitors, signage, staffing, supplies, services, etc.
- Funds cannot be used for any other parking or transportation services.
- If the event does not meet the above criteria, you must use standard event parking options for your event.
