TOTAL UNITS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATE CERTIFICATE: 18-19

- This option is intended primarily for graduate students who want to pursue an MA in English or another field, but also want to be prepared to teach ESL writing at the college level.
- Graduate students must have a completed bachelor's degree (in any field) with a 3.0 overall GPA.
- Students must either be in a degree program at Sacramento
 State or must apply for graduate admission to the
 University. Once admitted to Sacramento State, prospective
 TESOL Certificate students must apply to the TESOL Coordinator
 for admission to the program.
- International students must have a TOEFL score of 600 or higher (or a score of 250 or higher on the computerized TOEFL) and a score of 5 on the Test of Written English.
- Courses must be completed with grades of "B" or better.
- All coursework for the Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) Certificate must be taken at Sacramento State.
- The following courses may <u>not</u> be included towards the minor: ENGL 1, 1C, 1X, 2, 2X, 3, 3M, 5, 5M, 10, 10M, 11, 11M, 20, 20M, 60, 60M, 85, 86, 87, 109M, 109W, or 109X.
