Benefits

- Earn an extra yearly stipend (in most districts)
- Support students to grow academically in BOTH Spanish and English

About the Bilingual Authorization Pathway

- **Pre-requisites:** fluency in Spanish and one course in the culture of emphasis (e.g. Latin American History, Chicanx Studies, Ethnic Studies, note: may be waived dep. on experience).
- Take 1 course this summer through the College of Continuing Education (easy enrollment)
 - **Synchronous Zoom course**
 - Learn the history and research of bilingual programs in California
 - Develop new methods for bilingual teaching
 - Brush up on your academic Spanish with a course taught in Spanish
 - Connect with other bilingual educators
 - Conduct observations in dual language classrooms
