Teaching Credential and MAT

- First two or three semesters are for Teaching Credential courses only.
- 13 units (200 level courses) of the Teaching Credential courses will be counted towards the Master of Arts in Teaching.
- You must start the MAT during the summer semester.
 - 5 units in the summer semester
 - 6 units in the fall semester in the evening hours
 - 6 units in the spring semester in the evening hours

OGS New Graduate Student Orientation

- This is a new requirement, and it applies to all students in the teaching credential program even if they do not plan on continuing with the MAT.

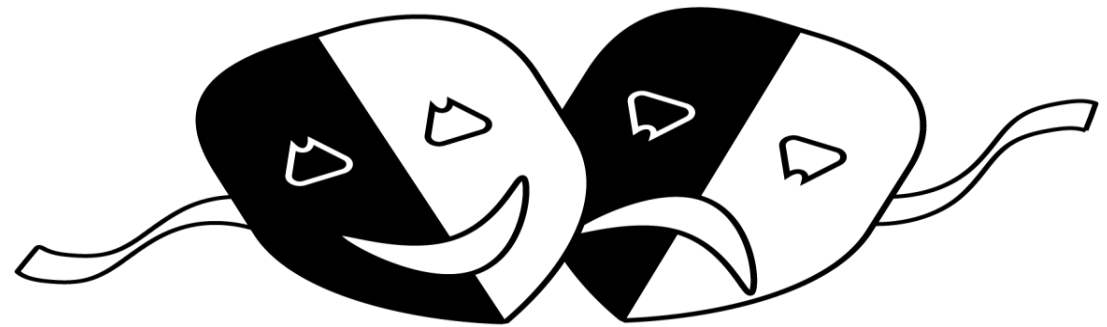


There are **FOUR F2F** sessions. You only need to attend **ONE** of them
