U.S Constitution Requirement

California Education Code Section 44335 requires all candidates for a Multiple Subject, Single Subject, Education Specialist, or Designated Subjects Credential to demonstrate knowledge of the United States Constitution by completing a college-level course with a minimum "C" grade, or a college level examination in the subject. This requirement must be completed before the credential can be granted. The U.S. Constitution requirement can be met by successful completion of one of the following:

- 1. A course that covers the provisions and principles of the U.S. Constitution completed at a regionally accredited community college, four-year college, or university.
 - CSU grads will have automatically completed a course (either at a community college prior to transfer or at their CSU campus). But to meet the requirement, a grade of "C" or better must be earned in the course;
 - At Sacramento State, either GOVT 1 or GOVT 150 will meet the requirement;
 - IF you are unsure if you completed a course (UC's and Private Colleges may not require this for graduation), contact the Teaching Credentials Department in Eureka Hall 401 or call (916) 278-6639. You will need to provide a copy of the course description that you believe meets the requirement.
- 2. AP Credit (CSU, UC, or Other): AP credit posted on an official transcript showing credit for either:
 - AP American Government, or
 - AP American History
- 3. Pass an examination on the provisions and principles of the U.S. Constitution offered by a regionally accredited college or university. Institutions offering an appropriate college-level examination are:
 - American River College, Natomas Education Center
