PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & PRELIMINARY PROGRESS

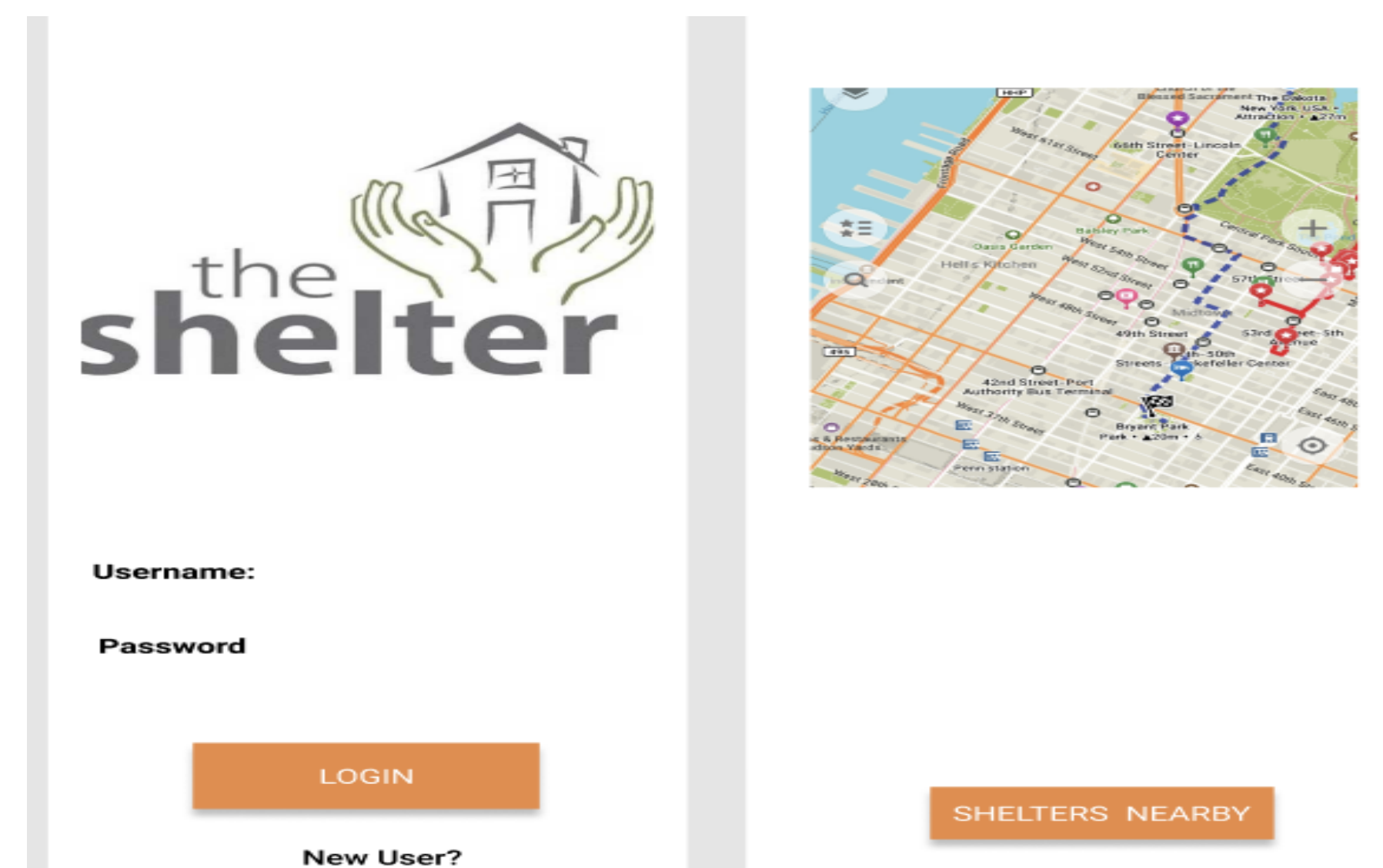
- This idea will be implemented as a web application which will only be accessed by CSUS students.
- Need to work on prototypes, and user interface designs, followed by coding and development.
- Should work a marketing strategy to promote awareness and adoption of the application among the CSUS student body.
- Need to get an approval from CARES department to access their resources.

POTENTIAL CHALLENGES

- One major challenge could be limited resources, including budget constraints and availability of skilled personnel
- Another challenge could be stakeholder resistance or lack of buy-in, particularly from university administrators or departments responsible for implementing and supporting the application.
- Furthermore, technical challenges such as system integration issues or scalability concerns may arise during development and deployment.

BACKGROUND

- The inspiration for this project stems from the shared struggles experienced during the pandemic, especially for international students like me. When the campus closed, many of us couldn't work or afford basic necessities. Conversations with other Sac State students highlighted a major issue: most students weren't aware of the CARES office and its emergency housing support. It was clear that many students didn't know where to turn if they were in a housing crisis. So, we brainstormed and came up with the Emergency Housing Application for CSUS students to address this gap in knowledge.

- Complete application development could be completed with the help of CS department, If this project is approved, I need to communicate with the senior project coordinator to look for a team to work on.

- Increase Awareness and Utilization of CARES Emergency Housing Services
