Good Standing

The Chancellor's Office of the California State University system and the Office of Graduate Studies at Sacramento State require a 3.0 GPA or above to be considered in good academic standing. No grade below a B for any didactic, clinical, or research course will count toward the degree requirement. If a student's GPA falls below 3.0, the student will be placed on academic probation. Students on probation will be placed on Continued Probation if they earn a 3.00 GPA in the current semester but have a cumulative GPA below 3.00. If a student is on academic probation and the cumulative GPA is below 3.0 for the active term, the student will be academically disqualified. Students not on probation will be disqualified if the GPA is 2.000 or less. Disqualified students will not be allowed to register unless they are formally reinstated and/or readmitted to the University.
