### **Program Detail**

### Cognitive Function in Aging: Healthy Brain vs. Mild Cognitive Impairment and Dementia

Dr. Chen will compare healthy brain aging to mild cognitive impairment and dementia. She will explain ways to maintain cognitive function in aging, what is normal and abnormal brain function, and when to seek care. Dr. Chen leads the clinical drug trials unit at UC Davis Health's Alzheimer's Disease Center. She has an interest in both disease-modifying therapies and symptomatic therapies for Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. She is also interested in understanding ways to increase the accessibility and inclusion of participants from underrepresented groups in clinical trials. Dr. Chen received her undergraduate degree at UC Berkeley and her neurology residency at UC Davis.


# SacLink accounts for Zoom & Classroom Tech




- All leaders using Zoom should have an account for this semester




### On Campus
