Golf Cart Guidelines

- 1. The 2-seater golf cart will be available for pick up at the North Village Housing Complex Saturday, October 28th at 8:30 a.m. Cart will be charged and ready to use.
- 2. The cart can be borrowed from October 28th at 8:30 a.m., until the conclusion of the Homecoming Halftime Parade.
- 3. The borrower of the cart shall not use the cart for any purpose other than for practice driving, decoration for the Homecoming Parade, driving to and from decorating, and the field/parade.
- 4. Cart may not be driven off campus at any time, for any reason.
- 5. During all times the vehicle is in motion, each person in the cart must be seated alone in a seat. No more people will be allowed in the cart than there are seats.
- 6. At the time of return, all decorations will be removed from the carts.
- 7. The cart must be returned without damage of any kind.
 - a. Major damage concerns include crashing the cart, a broken or cracked frame or fenders, broken windshield, holes or punctures in the seats, or loss by theft.
- 8. In the event of damage, the individual and/or group is responsible for paying to repair or replace the cart, depending on the extent of damage as determined by the vendor. "Liable" and "responsible" mean that the party and/or parties will pay for minor or major damages to carts. In the event the cart is damaged beyond economical repair, the replacement cost is approximately \$4,000 (each cart valued differently).
- 9. No sharp turns shall be made while driving the golf cart on and off the field. Sharp turns can destroy rubberized tracks, which the driver will be liable for.
- 10. Only those who are authorized to drive by Risk Management will be authorized to operate the carts, including pickup and turn-in.
- 11. The driver of the cart should have at least 15 minutes of driving experience in their borrowed golf cart prior to participating in the parade.
- 12. Decorating the cart must adhere to the following guidelines:
 - a. Show Hornet Pride!
 - b. Decorating starts on Saturday, October 28th, at 9am and ends at 2pm.
 - c. Decorating budget must not exceed \$75
 - i. Cart decorators are encouraged to reduce, reuse & recycle

- d. No duct tape or glue is to be used directly onto the cart
- e. No spray paint is to be used directly onto the cart
- f. Use of glitter is acceptable as long as you can clean it off/wash the cart within 30 minutes after the halftime show
- g. Golf Cart decorations must not exceed 10' 4" in height (road to top)
- h. Use decorations that reduce our environmental impact.
 - i. Spray painted cardboard and metalized plastic cannot be recycled
 - ii. Bins will be provided at the end of the parade for appropriate disposal of all unwanted decorations
