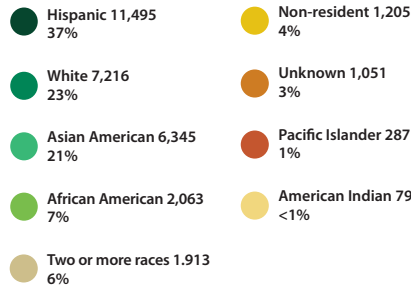
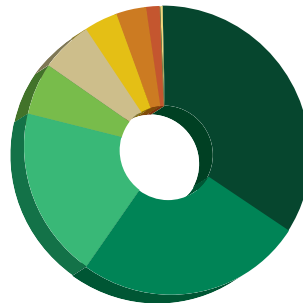

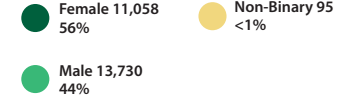
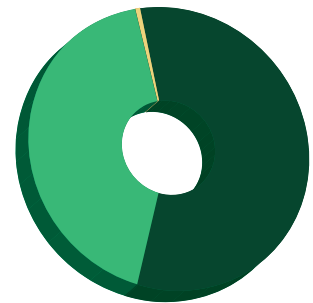
Enrollment by Ethnicity
