California E-Bike Incentive Project

What is the California E-Bike Incentive Project?

The California E-Bike Incentive Project provides qualified residents with up to \$2,000 to support the purchase of a new electric bicycle (e-bike). The first application window opens Wednesday, December 18th, at 6:00 PM PST—and it's first-come, first-served for the first 1,500 applicants. Read more below to learn about eligibility.

You must be a California resident 18 years or older

You can verify residency using your current, valid California Driver's License, California AB 60 License, or California ID Card.

There are two ways to determine if you are eligible for the incentive.

First way: Meet the income requirement.

A. Count the number of people in your household.

Second way: Participate in a public assistance program.

You may be automatically eligible if you participate in one of the following programs:

- Medicaid
- Medi-Cal (Income Qualified Medi-Cal Only)
- SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
- CAPI (Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants)
- · Access Clean California
- Driving Clean Assistance Program
- Regional Clean Cars 4 All
- Section 8 Rental Certificate Program for Very Low and Extremely Low Income classifications (HUD)
- If approved, you'll receive a voucher via email

 Vouchers can be used to purchase a new e-bike at an approved retailer.
- What kind of e-bike can you purchase?

 Here are the three types of e-bikes eligible for the incentive.







Types of e-bikes that are not eligible:

Used e-bikes. E-bike conversion kits. Bikes modified with e-bike conversion kits. E-bikes outside of the 3 class system. E-bikes without integrated lights. Scooters and Mopeds.
